Purpose Statement

The purpose of the Schenk-Atwood-Starkweather-Yahara Neighborhood Association, Inc. (SASY) is to carry forward the mission of the heretofore unincorporated neighborhood association of the same name and geographic location. That mission is stated as follows:

To advocate for a better community for its residents, businesses and visitors through an open, consensual process. SASY will accomplish this mission by:

Identifying neighborhood needs and priorities;

 Building trust and a spirit of community in the neighborhood and promoting neighborhood planning;

Protecting the diverse neighborhood character;

Partnering with neighborhood groups (business associations, non-profits, other);

Providing an organizational mechanism to address needs.

Additional Provisions

The following provisions are made part of the organizational bylaws for SASY:

- No part of the earnings of this corporation will inure to the benefit of
 private shareholders or individuals, except that the corporation shall be
 authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.
- 2. No activities of the corporation shall attempt to influence legislation except as may be permitted under provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- This corporation is dedicated to exclusively charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes, and, in the even of dissolution, any remaining assets shall be distributed to organizations which shall at that time qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

- 4. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by:
 - a. a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

or

- b. a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- 5. The corporation shall not participate to any extent in a political campaign for or against any candidate for public office.

DISSOLUTION CLAUSE

Upon dissolution of SASY, after all debts and obligations of the corporation are paid, its assets, if any, shall be distributed, subject to any necessary judicial approval, to an organization or organizations then described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, except that no Member shall be eligible to receive assets from the Corporation upon dissolution.
