Purpose (goal) of Committee:

The mission of the SASY Transportation Committee is to promote a safe, sustainable, walkable & bikeable, multimodal neighborhood. The committee will work with residents of the SASY neighborhood, SASY businesses, city staff & elected representatives to identify, educate, develop policy and evaluate implementation & results regarding:

- Short & long-range transportation infrastructure needs
- Proposed and planned projects, impacts & issues
- Transportation-related values, priorities and needs of residents & businesses

The committee will serve as the initial consultation for transportation-related design, development, construction & repair in the neighborhood: infrastructure, pedestrian, bicycle, mass-transit, motor vehicle & snow removal. The committee will make recommendations to the SASY Council.

Specific issue(s) to report:

I'm currently scheduling a neighborhood meeting with DOT for a presentation by DOT regarding the Highway 51 proposed construction. The neighborhood meeting will take place on Thursday October 3, October 24, or November 7, 6:30-8:30pm at the Goodman Community Center, Evjue Room D.

Recommendation(s):

The Transportation Committee is recommending the SASYNA Council submit the following recommended changes to the Draft 2014-2018 TIP plan as a written comment which must be submitted by the Sept 20 deadline:

1. Milwaukee Street: add bike lanes to the bridge over the east branch of Starkweather Creek and through the Fair Oaks intersection. (Page 45 of Aug 2013 Draft TIP)
2. On Winnebago Street, add bumpouts at pedestrian crossings, and either narrow the street or add bike lanes on both sides from Schenks Corners to La Follette Ave. (Page 47 of Aug 2013 Draft TIP)
3. On Atwood, add bike lanes from Fair Oaks to Walter Street. (Page 42 of Aug 2013 Draft TIP)
